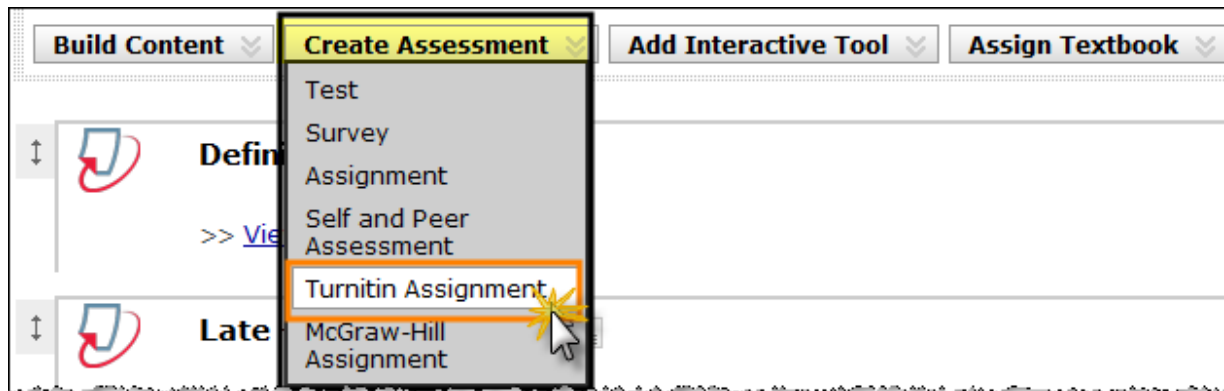


Getting Started with Turnitin Using Blackboard 9

Turnitin is fully integrated with Bb9, meaning that as an instructor, you are able to create Turnitin Assignments through Blackboard Learn 9.

Step 1 – Creating Turnitin Assignments with Bb 9

Faculty will create the assignment in Bb9 within the Menu displayed for the class (see Menu snapshot). Assignments will be created within a Content button - A content area will have the following options of Build Content, Create Assessment, Add Interactive Tool, and Assign Textbook



*An assignment is ALWAYS created by clicking on the **Create Assessment** Button because they are part of the Grade Center*

Student will submit an assignment in Bb9 by clicking on the button you create the Turnitin Assignment

ASSIGNMENT PROPERTIES

An instructor will set up the properties when the assignment is created.

TIP: When you first use Turnitin you will acknowledge that you are at least 13 years of age to continue.

Step 2 – Select the type of Assignment you want to create

Assignment Title Required, and option for Grammar check (this is in Beta Testing –only faculty will see grammar check)


